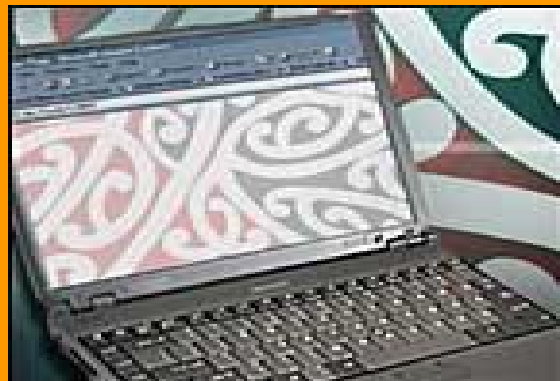

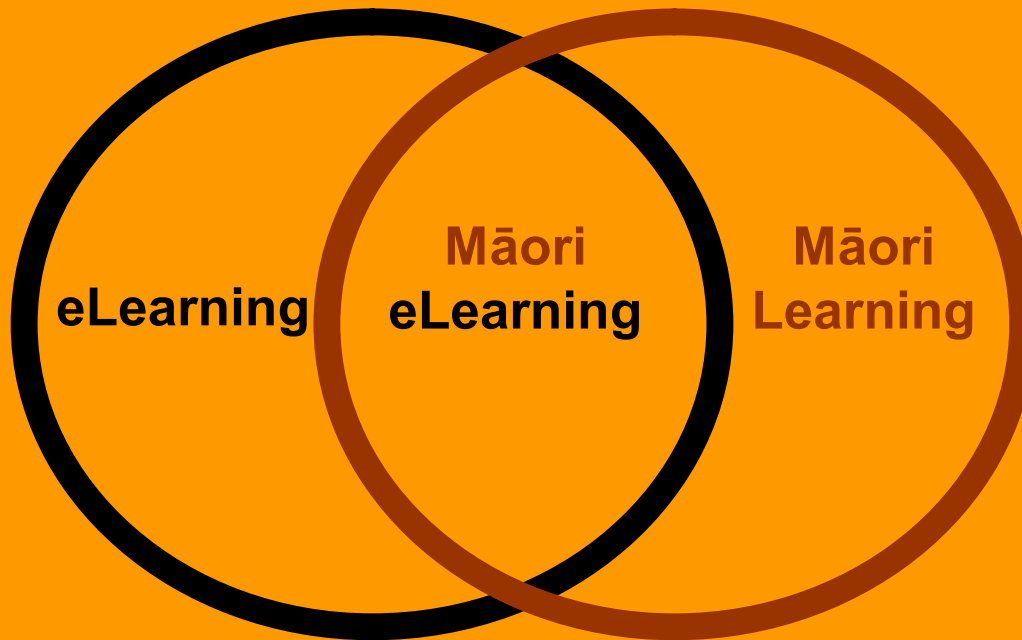

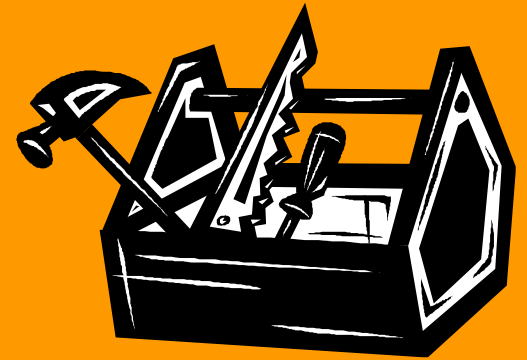
How can we ...
